Getting to the Cover Sheet

1. Determine what items will be included.
 - a. What HB1010 requires for IRPs
 - b. Other items that make sense for assessing adequacy
2. Define the items
 - a. How are the items computed?
 - i. Where does the data come from:
 1. Utility's own data
 2. From outside sources: BPA, PNUCC?
 - ii. Who determines definitions: e.g. when does the year begin?
 - b. Consistency with
 - i. other reports, esp. PNUCC's loads and resources survey
 - ii. individual utility practice and needs
 - iii. other statutes, esp. I-937
3. Mechanics of reporting
 - a. What does CTED need to do receive cover sheets electronically?
 - b. Coordination with PNUCC data submissions
4. IRPs in general
 - a. Does CTED need to be at all prescriptive about IRP formats beyond what is in HB1010?
 - b. Would a workshop or training be helpful?
