




# Local Review: Priority Lists

- Prioritization performed by local groups that developed subbasin plans
- Each subbasin will submit a separate list of fish & wildlife project priorities, ranked list.
- Guided by subbasin priorities and subbasin plans
- List submitted to Oregon Subbasin Plan Implementation Team by April 30, 2006.



# Oregon Subbasin Plan Implementation Team (OSPIT)

- Composed of tribal co-managers, state agencies (ODFW, OWEB, WRD, ODEQ, Governor's Office), Federal agencies (NMFS, USFWS, BPA, COE)
- Develops Oregon provincial recommendations
- Takes lists from subbasins in province and prioritizes from subbasin lists
- May substitute priorities within a subbasin, but only if concurrence from all that error occurred
- May adjust priorities to conform to ISRP recommendations
- Work complete by June 16, 2006

# Council Draft Recommendation

- Oregon Council works with Idaho or Washington counterparts.
- OSPIT recommendation forms basis for Oregon Council position
- Utilize federal agencies and tribal governments to develop overall province recommendation
- ESA and tribal concerns considered in developing province budget
